



News Brief June 9, 2015 Meeting Report

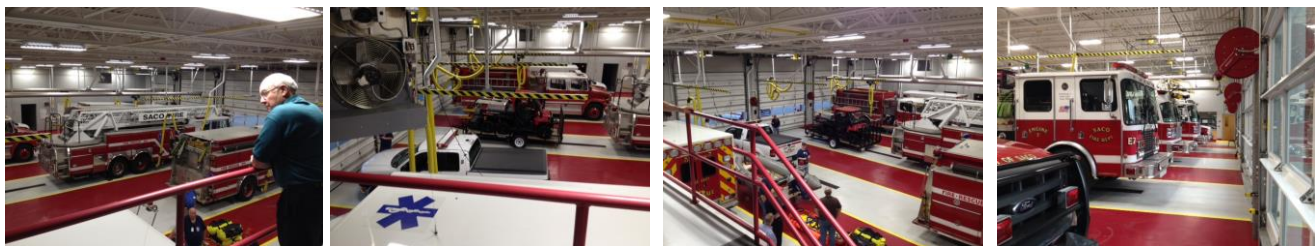
Our June meeting was at the facilities of the Saco Fire Department.
